



Installing CC4 Anywhere (Windows)

What it does

CC4 Anywhere lets you connect to your school/college network using many kinds of computing device. You can use programs from a computer where they aren't even installed, and do your work wherever and whenever you want – not just at your school or college, but from anywhere you can use the Internet.

Not using Windows?

Installing CC4 Anywhere QuickStart guides are available for other platforms, e.g. Apple Mac, Linux® and various mobile phone/PDA operating systems. Ask your network administrator or teacher for the version you need.

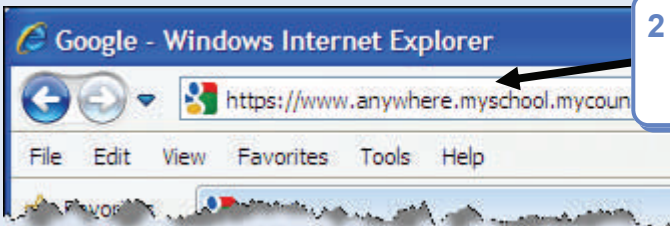
What you need for CC4 Anywhere (Windows)

- A computer (desktop, laptop or other mobile computer) that runs one of these Microsoft® operating systems: **Windows® XP, Windows Vista® or Windows 7.**
- A wired or wireless connection to the Internet.
- A CC4 network username and password.
- If possible you should install the **CC4 Anywhere Web client** program. To do this you need permission to install programs on your computing device (you need 'administrative rights'). Normally, if it's your own computer, you'll be allowed to do this. If you aren't allowed to install programs on the computer you're using, try the **Java client** (overpage).

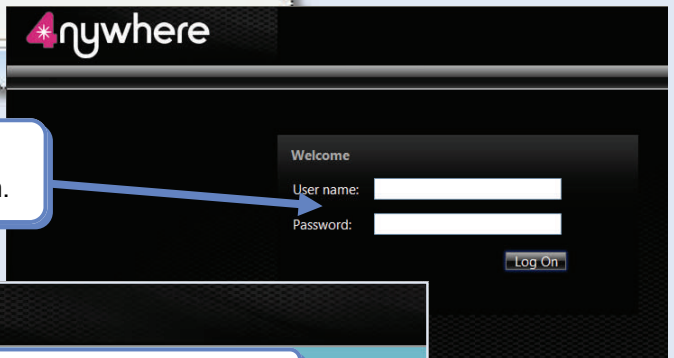
Installing the CC4 Anywhere Web client

1 Connect your computer to the Internet, and log on.

2 Open your browser (e.g., Internet Explorer®) and browse to your CC4 Anywhere website. (Your network administrator or teacher can give you the address.)



3 At the logon page, type in your network Username and Password. Click **Log On**.



4 To download the client you must read and accept the licence agreement. Click the box to accept...

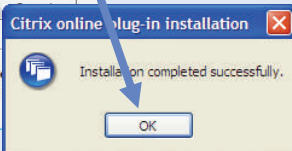
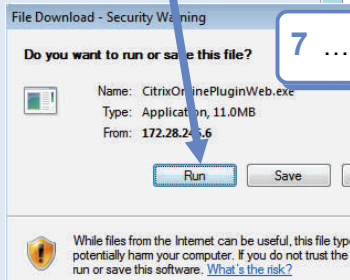
5 ...then click **Download**.

Can't download? Try the Java client (overpage).

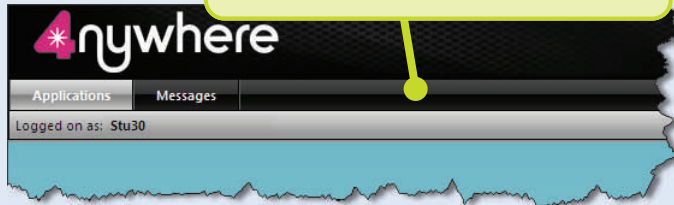


6 Click **Run...**

7 ...and **OK** to finish.

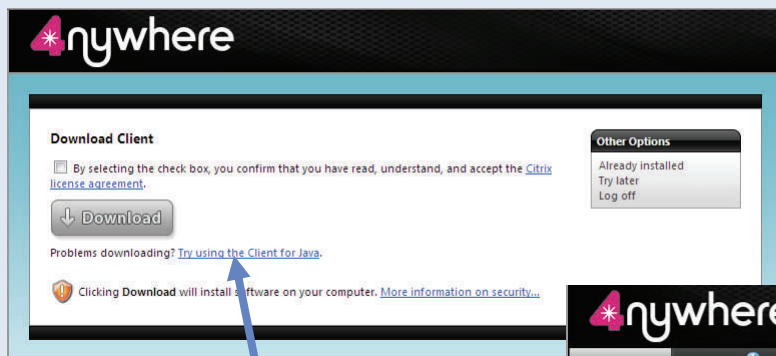

Using the client for Java

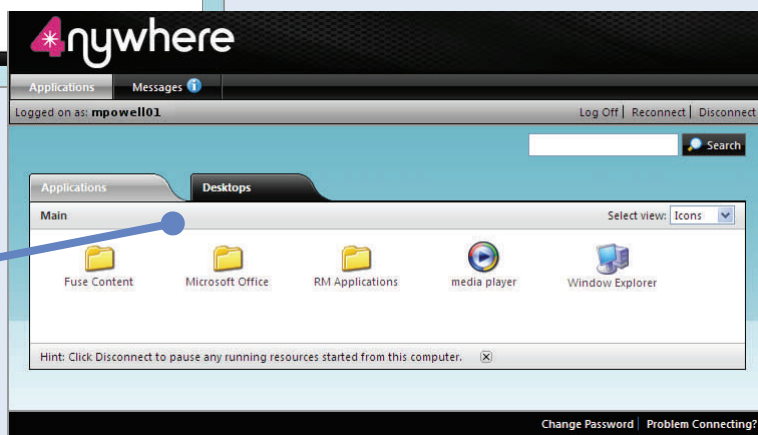
If you don't have permission to install the CC4 Anywhere client on the computer you're using, you can probably still get CC4 Anywhere using the Java client.



1 Click **Try using the Client for Java**.*

2 That's it – your CC4 applications (programs) and desktop(s) are ready to use.

*If you **can't** see the **Try using the Client for Java** link, it means that 'Java Runtime Environment' hasn't been installed on your computer. Without it you can't use the Java client (see Help below).



Next time you connect

On the same computer, just browse to the CC4 Anywhere website and log on.

- If the CC4 Anywhere client has been installed on your computer, your applications (programs) and desktop will be available straight away.
- If the client hasn't been installed, you'll again be shown the Download Client page. Again you'll have the option to try using the Java client.

On every other computing device where you want to use CC4 Anywhere, you'll need to install the CC4 Anywhere client, or choose the Java client if you can.

Help!

- *I'm being asked to install a website security certificate. What should I do?*

Ask your teacher or network administrator.

- *Why doesn't the Download button work?*

Ensure you have ticked the box to accept the licence agreement. This activates the Download button.

- *How can I install 'Java Runtime Environment'?*

Try typing that name into a search engine, e.g. Google, to find a website where you can download it. You may not be permitted to install Java on the computer you're using. (And if you are allowed, why not install the CC4 Anywhere Client instead?)
