## NVQ Level 2 Hairdressing

- Entry qualifications: none, although candidates are strongly urged to have completed their GCSE year
- Two-year day release to coincide with an apprenticeship
- Continuous assessment
- Projects and assignments
- Official short answer examinations
- Tutor lead theoretical work and art and design
- IT support

- Advise and consult with clients
- Shampoo and condition hair and scalp
- Style hair using drying techniques
- Cut hair using basic techniques
- Perm and neutralise hair
- Change hair colour using basic techniques
- Fulfil salon reception duties
- Develop and maintain effective teamwork and relationships
- Support the health, safety and security of the salon environment
- Cut hair using barbering techniques
