Computer Aided Design

City & Guilds Level 2

This course is designed for the complete beginner or for those who have very little experience or knowledge of AutoCAD. It will also provide the student with a good foundation of knowledge in the understanding and use of AutoCAD.

Students who successfully complete this course will gain a nationally recognised City and Guilds qualification on two dimensional computer aided design.

It would be advantageous for candidates to have some experience of using a computer and to be familiar with Windows software.

Duration:

One term (12 weeks x 2.5 hours per session).

Course fee - £252 per term.

City & Guilds Level 3

This course is designed for the person who has experience in the use of AutoCAD or has previously completed Level Two and would like to embark on a more challenging course, leading to the nationally recognised City and Guilds qualification in two dimensional computer aided design.

This course can lead to the more advanced 3D CAD course, that will run at a later date.

As with the previous course, students on this course will not just benefit by having a recognised qualification, but should have the depth and breadth of knowledge to sustain a career as a CAD operator in industry.

Duration:

One term (12 weeks x 2.5 hours per session).

Course fee - £252 per term.

City & Guilds Level 4

This course is designed for the more experienced student who has completed levels two and three. It leads to the highest City and Guilds qualification in two dimensional computer aided design.

This course will provide the user with a comprehensive understanding of computer aided design.

Students on this course will not just benefit by having a recognised qualification but should have the depth and breadth of knowledge to sustain a career as a CAD operator in industry.

Duration:

One term (12 weeks x 2.5 hours per session).
