## Electrical Installation CGLI 2360 and 'C' Certificate

The students should be craft apprentices working in the electrical contracting industry, supply industry or those whose work involves electrical installation, maintenance, repair or modification of existing installation.

The structure of the course is in line with the requirements of the electrical contracting industry providing all levels of manpower both in Guernsey and the UK. The course provides continued study in preparation for advancement in the industry.

### Aims of the course:

To provide the knowledge and appreciation of techniques and materials relevant to the industry.

## Subjects studied

Certification:

The course allows for certificates at three levels as follows:

**2360 Part 1** - A basic course consisting of a minimum of two years and two terms.

Attendance is one day per week plus one evening.

**2360 Part 11** - Provides a greater understanding of the regulations. Minimum attendance one year and one term.

Attendance is one day per week plus one evening.

## Subjects studied

**2360 Course 'C'** - This course requires advanced study and provides the requisite technical knowledge for a Technician Electrician as defined by the Joint Industry Board for the electrical contracting industry.

Note: Previous success in CGLI 2360 Part 1 and Part 11 certificates is required for entry to this course. An important part of course 'C' work is the electrical installation project which is carried out under supervision.

Mode of attendance:

1st year - one day per week

2nd year - two evenings per week
