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NVQ Level 1 Hospitality & Catering

- No formal entry qualifications required
- Basic educational grounding
- Students will be required to attend an interview
- One year level one full-time course
- Up to 28 hours per week in College including key skills and recreational studies
- Provides a foundation for a career in Hotels, Inns and Restaurants
- Employment opportunities worldwide

NVQ Level 2 Hospitality & Catering

- Three GCSEs at Grade D or equivalent
- Two-year full-time course
- Students will be required to attend an interview
- Up to 28 hours per week in College including Key Skills and Recreational Studies
- Provides a foundation for a career in hotels, inns and restaurants
- Employment opportunities worldwide
