Learning support

The learning support team is able to offer all of our students help and support with their studies.

This includes help with English, maths, ICT and study skills.

The learning support team is able to give extra help to individual students in various ways, by

- helping to screen learners for appropriate courses
- providing technical expertise in the teaching of English (language and literacy), maths (including numeracy), ICT applications and study skills
- providing help for those students with learning gaps or blocks, especially where that arises from unsuccessful previous learning
- building learners' confidence, and teaching successful learning strategies

Learning differences

We want all of our students, regardless of what level courses they are studying, to do their very best and to fulfil their potential.

All members of the learning support team have an understanding of learning differences and the impact these may make on an individual's learning process.

Dyslexia

Some of the team are specialists in supporting dyslexic students.

If you are dyslexic, or suspect you may be, the team can arrange screening tests and provide the specialist support you may need.

You also may be entitled to special, extra support for your examinations.

Workshops

The learning support team operates three 'workshops'; one for English and literacy, one for maths and numeracy and one for ICT.

English workshop

Staff in the English workshop can provide you with help with your general literacy skills in spelling, grammar and punctuation. They can also give you assistance with your coursework.

Maths workshop

The maths workshop provides help with all aspects of mathematics and numeracy at all levels, from very basic right through to advanced.

ICT workshop

Here you can find help with a range of software applications including Word, Excel, PowerPoint, Email and Access.

All the staff in the workshops can also help with research and study skills.
