Performing Arts is an excellent preparation for employment in:

You could also seek employment in the performing arts and related industries such as theatre, film, television, community arts, arts management, broadcasting and journalism.

Students on the level 3 courses also have the opportunity to progress on to a higher education degree in any of the humanities subjects such as literature, languages, psychology, law, history, philosophy, art, social sciences, religion, music and teaching.

You could also progress on to a higher education degree in theatre, performance or training at a drama college (drama school)

Level 3 BTEC Diploma in Performing Arts

Entry requirements

This is a two year, full time course that is aimed at students who enjoy the practical aspects of performance. You will study skills like: voice, movement, dance, improvisation and acting techniques. Along the way you will also develop a range of creative and transferable skills like team work, communication, confidence and self reflection that will serve you in all aspects of your later life.

This course is an ideal preparation for employment, a career in performing or further study at university or drama school. The Level 3 Extended Diploma is equivalent to 3 A-levels and is awarded the same UCAS points.

You will be taught by a team of accomplished lecturers with extensive professional experience in the Performing Arts. Lessons are delivered through a combination of practical workshops, seminars, rehearsals and performances.

All students who come to the college are treated as adults who are ready to take responsibility for their learning and development. Ensuring that your learning journey is successful and rewarding is at the heart of everything we do.

The performing arts are a collaborative industry. Learning to work with other creative people is as much part of the course as learning individual skills. Studying performing arts will give you the opportunity to become a more confident, self motivated and expressive person.

- A level 2 qualification equivalent to 4-5 GCSEs at Grade A-C
- English GCSE at Grade C or above

You may be invited to attend an audition before being offered a place on this course.

Other opportunities

Students on the full time Level 3 Performing Arts courses are given the chance to attend a week long theatre residential in their first year of study.

The Performing Arts Centre has an extensive programme of live and filmed performances across the year. Students on the Performing Arts courses are often offered complimentary or discounted tickets for these shows.

Full-time students have an afternoon each week for a range of recreational activities and students are also encouraged to participate in the Students' Union.
