The Performing Arts courses provide you with a range of transferable skills that will prepare you to pursue many careers options.

Performing Arts is an excellent preparation for employment in:

- Customer services
- Sales
- Human resources
- Marketing
- Advertising

You could also seek employment in the performing arts and related industries such as theatre, film, television, community arts, arts management, broadcasting and journalism.

Students on the level 3 courses also have the opportunity to progress on to a higher education degree in any of the humanities subjects such as literature, languages, psychology, law, history, philosophy, art, social sciences, religion, music and teaching.

You could also progress on to a higher education degree in theatre, performance or training at a drama college (drama school)

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# Level 3 BTEC Certificate in Production Arts



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## Assessment

## Entry requirements

This is a one year part time course that will equip you with the practical skills and understanding to work backstage in a variety of technical theatre roles. The course is suitable for any students already studying a level 3 programme (BTEC or A-Level), or for mature students who would like to develop their practical skills.

The course is equivalent to 1 AS-level and is awarded the equivalent UCAS points. The course is delivered through workshops and practical sessions. You will develop the skills to fulfil a range of technical roles and to apply what you have learned on productions. The sessions are hands on and practical in nature and you will be learning through doing.

Assessment for this course is carried out through project portfolios, practical work on productions, tutor observation and self evaluation.

It is possible to extend your course of study for another year if you wish and to achieve the A-Level Equivalent BTEC Level 3 Subsidiary Diploma in Production Arts.

The course is ideally suited to students who are interested in working 'behind the scenes' in a professionally equipped theatre.

Any level 2 qualification equivalent to 4 GCSE Grade A-C

### Other opportunities

Students on the full time Level 3 Performing Arts courses are given the chance to attend a week long theatre residential in their first year of study.

The Performing Arts Centre has an extensive programme of live and filmed performances across the year. Students on the Performing Arts courses are often offered complimentary or discounted tickets for these shows.

Full-time students have an afternoon each week for a range of recreational activities and students are also encouraged to participate in the Students' Union.
