BTEC First Diploma in Media Production Level 2

This exciting one-year course is run on a practical basis that will provide you with a broad introduction to the worlds of photography, advertising and film.

You will gain an insight into the working of the media industry and acquire technical skills in media production.

The subjects covered include:

- Photography
- Video editing
- Animation
- Television production
- Advertising
- Graphic design
- Web design

Assessment will be mainly through different project-based assignments. You will employ different methods of communication skills when compiling your assignments by using visual and written work as well as oral representation, both individually or as part of a group. This will culminate in an externally assessed production.

Entry requirements

Four GCSE grades D to E

On successful completion of this course you will be eligible to progress on to Level 3 courses in Communication, Media, Photography and Television or enter trainee employment in the media industry.

For both these media courses you will have access to professional video equipment and the latest industry standard software.

We have various links with outside producers to help guide the media experience of the student.

Media students will also have access to the Princess Royal Centre for film screenings.

BTEC National Diploma in Media Production Level 3

This two-year practical course will give you a broad introduction into the world of photography, advertising, journalism, TV and film.

You will gain an insight into the working of the media industry and acquire technical skills in media production.

The subjects covered include:

- Photography
- Animation
- Film studies
- Television production
- Video editing
- Graphic design
- Interactive media
- Web design
- Interview techniques
- Music video production

Assessment will be mainly through a variety of project-based assignments. You will employ different methods of communication skills when compiling your assignments by using visual and written work as well as oral representation, both individually or as part of a group.

You will secure your own work placement, preferably in your chosen area, to experience and to develop your existing knowledge. The course will culminate in an externally assessed final major project.
