



You will be assessed through a variety of methods which may include practical demonstration of your skills through performance units, actor's log, relevant documentation, such as lighting cue sheets and performance evaluations.

You may also be assessed through oral presentations, both individually or as part of a group.

On successful completion of this course you will be eligible to progress onto drama school, to study at higher education or transfer your skills into the work place.

Btec First Diploma in Performing Arts Level Two

Btec National Diploma in Performing Arts Level Three

Btec First Diploma in Performing Arts Level Two

This exciting one-year course will introduce you to all areas of the performing arts. It is a very practical course where you will work on a range of projects, culminating in a final production which could be a musical or a one act play.

Units which may be covered include:

- Acting
- Introduction to improvisation
- Devising work
- Musical theatre
- Design theatre
- Crewing for stage performance
- The performing arts business

Assessment will be carried out for each major project or unit you take part in. You will employ a variety of methods for completing assignments which will include written evaluations, actor's log, performances and oral feedback.

On successful completion of this course you will hold a level two qualification. You would then be eligible to progress by auditioning for the Btec National Diploma in Performing Arts (level three) or apply for an equivalent level three qualification.

Btec National Diploma in Performing Arts Level Three

This two-year practical course will expose you to a variety of performance disciplines which will include a series of productions culminating in a final major acting project.

You will work as part of a production team and run the company as if you were the theatre's 'in-house theatre company'.

Throughout the duration of this course you will gain valuable industry related experience and acquire performance and production skills which will provide a strong foundation for any future work within the industry.

Units may include:

- Performance workshop
- Dance performance
- Physical theatre
- Acting 1
- Voice 1
- Movement 1
- Contemporary theatre performance
- Theatre for children
- Scriptwriting
- Acting for TV and film
- Musical theatre

Other opportunities

You will also have opportunities to develop your essential life skills of numeracy, communications and IT.

Opportunities will exist for students to successfully complete their GCSEs in Mathematics and English if they need to.

Full-time students have an afternoon each week for a range of recreational activities and students are also encouraged to participate in the Students' Union.

Opportunities for Progression

The Performing Arts courses provide you with a range of excellent transferable skills preparing you either to pursue many careers available locally or within the performing arts industries.

Students on the level three courses also have the opportunity to progress to university or drama school in the UK.
