# CACHE Level 3 Diploma for the Children and Young People's Workforce

## Content

## Assessment strategies

A part time course for mature students who are working or intending to work with children and young people. It is expected that you already work in settings or services whose main purpose is children's care, learning and development and you have a level 2 childcare qualification.

This QCF qualification provides occupational competence for the children and young people's workforce 0-19 years.

Examples include:

- nursery assistants
- creche workers
- special educational needs assistants
- working with young people

Applicants must have a level 2 qualification and experience as a practitioner. The diploma prepares you to work unsupervised, or in a supervisory capacity.

The course consists of mandatory units, pathway units and optional units:

- communication
- child development
- duty of care
- developing positive relationships with others involved in care
- engaging in personal development

The diploma will require 65 credits in total.

A range of assessment methods used including direct observation, written assignments and professional discussion.
