BTEC National Diploma in Travel & Tourism

- Entry qualification: four GCSEs at grade 'C' or above
- Work related study
- Two-year full-time course
- Equivalent to 2/3 GCEs at 'A' Level
- Up to 25 hours in College, including additional and recreational studies
- Includes a study visit to a UK or European tourist destination
- Opportunities to work alongside local tourism businesses/work experience
- Provides a preparation for either employment or higher education
- Provides an in-depth knowledge of the Travel and Tourism industries
