



# Buy into your future


The Guernsey Apprenticeship offers you the opportunity to earn a salary and gain a nationally recognised technical, professional or vocational qualification in a job you love. You will need to have secured employment before applying or look at the 'Apprenticeship Vacancies' on our website.



This course is aimed at those wishing to pursue a career within Retail Management.

Working closely with your employer, it allows you to learn, develop and practise the skills required for progression in the sector.





This apprenticeship has 3 pathway options, each one dictates the length of the apprenticeship. These are:

Level 2 for 1 year Level 3 for 1 year Levels 2 and 3 for 2 years

You will attend College for one day a week for off-the-job training

- > Certificate of Apprenticeship




## Next Course Start Date

You can start working with an employer at anytime of the year, however, you will start your apprenticeship training in September 2019. The Level 3 apprenticeship will start in September 2020.


You will be assessed throughout the duration of the apprenticeship in the following ways:

- > ePortfolio
- > Observation
- > Written assignments
- > Witness testimony
- > Presentations
- > Blog
- > Project work



These courses are designed to support apprentices into a range of retail supervisory and management roles.





Apprenticeships are available to all.

You will be assessed for suitability for this apprenticeship using a range of diagnostic assessments with support and guidance offered where necessary.

As a guideline, candidates should have the following previous qualifications: **Level 2** entry - a minimum of 4 GCSEs at grade D/3 or equivalent. **Level 3** entry - a minimum of 5 GCSEs at grade C/4 or equivalent, including English.

However, all candidates will be considered and assessed on an individual basis and supported in any initial study required before starting the course.

If you have not achieved your maths and English qualifications, you will be required to complete a functional skills programme through the College, before completion of the course.

Entry to the Level 3 qualification will be dependent on the successful completion of the Level 2 Certificate or equivalent, as detailed above.



The College's Learner Support Services are available to provide support and help to make a success of your apprenticeship journey.

The College also works in partnership with Careers Guernsey whose advisors can support you in helping to choose the right next step for you and your future plans.
