# What we offer

This course is available to employees currently working in the construction and the built environment sector. Working closely with your employer, it allows you to learn, develop and practice the skills required for progression in the sector, emerging as professional, self-reflecting individuals.





### Course duration

The recommended time for completion of this course is 2 to 3 years. You will attend College for one day a week for off-the-job training.

- > Creation of design documents




## The onward journey

This apprenticeship will prepare you to be able to meet the demands of employers in the construction and the built environment sector and adapt to a constantly changing world. The qualifications aim to widen access to higher education and enhance the career prospects of those who undertake them.

After successfully completing your Level 4 apprenticeship, you will be able to apply to the BSc (Hons) Degree in Architectural Technology or Construction Management at the College.





Apprenticeships are available to all.

#### Level 3 - Three year apprenticeship

Candidates with a minimum of five GCSEs at grade C/4 or above or a Level 2 qualification in a relevant subject area with a merit grade or above. Applicants who can demonstrate a prior knowledge of the subject area through work experience will also be considered for this apprenticeship.

#### Level 4 - Two year apprenticeship (next available in 2020-2021)

Candidates with a Level 3 qualification or A levels in the relevant subject areas, these can be supported by GCSEs grade A\*-C. Entry to the Level 4 qualification will be dependent on successful completion of the Level 3 Certificate.

If you have not achieved your maths and English qualifications, you will be required to complete a functional skills programme through the College, before completion of the course.

The College's Learner Support Services are available to provide support and help to make a success of your apprenticeship journey.

The College also works in partnership with Careers Guernsey whose advisors can support you in helping to choose the right next step for you and your future plans.
