

Progression opportunities

Over 50% of our Level 3 students progress to prestigious universities and art colleges. They also have the opportunity to study the Higher National Diploma in Art and Design at the College which has been designed to appeal to those students looking for careers within the creative sector on the island. Those who have chosen to remain on the island have been successful in finding employment due to the wide range of essential skills they have developed.

Course outline

Level 2: Diploma in Art and Design Level 3: Extended Diploma in Art and Design

The course is delivered through a series of Art and Design projects that enable students to develop their skills in a wide range of creative media such as drawing, painting, sculpture, 3D animation, film making, computer games and graphic design. Students will gain both fine art and digital skills on the course and the project structure allows them to explore their area of special interest. All students will have the opportunity to exhibit their work at our end of vear shows

The course equips the students with a combination of practical skills and theory in order that they will be successful in entering the creative world through either university or industry.

Entry criteria

Level 2: Four GCSEs at grade D/3 or above, across a range of subjects including English Language.

Additional learning support

As part of your learning programme, if you have not yet attained a grade C/4 or equivalent in mathematics and English language, you will be required to study a Functional Skill or GCSE in these subjects.

During your course, your personal tutor will be able to guide you on how best to access support.
