

Give your career a makeover The Guernsey Apprenticeship offers you the opportunity to earn a salary and gain a nationally recognised technical, professional or vocational qualification in a job you love. You will need to have secured employment before applying or look at the 'Apprenticeship Vacancies' on our website.





This course is available to employees currently working in the painting, decorating and construction industries. Working closely with your employer, it allows you to demonstrate and recognise your skills, knowledge and understanding and to progress in the sector, with the opportunity to move on to further study if desired.



Course duration

The recommended time for completion of this course is 3 years. You will attend College for one day a week for off-the-job training.



Qualifications gained

- > Cskills Level 1 Diploma in Painting and Decorating (Construction)
- > Cskills Level 2 Diploma in Painting and Decorating (Construction)
- > Certificate of Apprenticeship

These qualifications are supported by the Painting and Decorating Association (PDA).



Off-the-job learning will take place at Les Ozouets Campus, Guernsey College of Further Education.

Level 1 Diploma in Painting and Decorating

- Health, safety and welfare in construction and associated industries
- > Prepare common surface types for decoration
- > Erect and dismantle access equipment and working platforms
- > Apply basic paint systems by brush and roller
- > Produce standard decorative finishes
- Knowledge of technical information, quantities and communication with others
- > Knowledge of construction technology
- > Apply foundation and plain papers

Level 2 Diploma in Painting and Decorating

- > Produce specialist decorative finishes
- > Prepare surfaces for decoration
- ➤ Apply waterborne paint systems using high volume low pressure (HVLP) spray equipment
- > Apply standard papers to ceilings and walls
- > Apply paint systems by brush and roller







You will be assessed throughout the duration of the apprenticeship through multiple choice knowledge question exams and practical assignments.



After successfully completing your Level 2 apprenticeship, you will be able to apply for a Level 3 programme of study. This includes:

> Level 3 Extended Certificate in Construction and the Built Environment

This apprenticeship prepares you to be able to meet the demands of employers in the industry as well as set up on your own.






Apprenticeships are available to all.

You will be assessed for suitability using a range of online tests with support and guidance offered where necessary.

If you have not achieved your maths and English qualifications, you will be required to complete a functional skills programme through the College, before completion of the course.

Entry to the Level 2 qualification will be dependent on successful completion of the Level 1 Diploma.
