BTEC Level 5 HND in Construction & The Built Environment – Construction Management







Course outline

The BTEC Level 5 HND in Construction and The Built Environment – Construction Management offers students a specialist pathway, designed to support progression into employment or on to degree-level study. The construction management pathway is ideal for those who are interested in or already working in the sector as a design co-ordinator, construction site supervisor, design technician, site manager or project manager. Students will develop a sound understanding of the principles of construction management and will learn to apply these principles more widely. The course covers a broad spectrum of subject areas that are relevant to develop a wider understanding of the construction industry.

Entry requirements

Students need to be employed within the construction industry to be able to access the course and have the relevant experience and/or qualifications, such as:

- BTEC Level 4 HNC Construction and the Built Environment
- Industry specialists who have a previous Level 4 HNC qualification in a construction related area

Any applicant who is not coming directly from completing the College BTEC Level 4 HNC Construction & The Built Environment course will need to attend an interview to establish suitability for the course.

Course content

Students will study the following units:

Year 1

- Contracts & Management
- Project Management
- Management of Complex Building Projects
- Alternative Energy Systems Design and Installation

t – Construction Management

Year 2

- Group Project
- Alternative Methods of Construction
- Maintenance & Operations

Progression opportunities

Students will continue with existing employment or progress to university on courses such as:

- BA/BSc Quantity Surveying
- BA/BSc Architectural Technology
- BA/BSc Construction Management
- BA/BSc Project Management
- BA/BSc Facilities Management

Course duration

Two years part-time with attendance at College one day per week.
