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Level 3 Award in Supporting Teaching and Learning has been specifically designed to teach the skills needed to begin working in schools and develops an understanding of the legislation, relationships and developmental techniques that are required for this role.

What skills will you need?

- A willingness to learn and participate in classroom-based activities with other learning ٠ support assistants
- An awareness of Google Classroom/Drive
- Basic IT skills and a willingness to work with IT to produce your work ٠
- A wilingness to share ideas, reflect on practice and to work with others to develop your . own practice
- A willingness to take opportunities to work with peers and shadow established Learning ٠ Support Assistants within your school
- A commitment to study outside school and College hours

Course content

The course comprises four units

- Understanding schools and colleges as organisations
- Supporting health and safety in a learning environment •
- Understanding how to safeguard children and young people .
- Understanding how children and young people develop

What will be required of you, the learner?

You will need to be able to study at a Level 3 standard and independently out of school hours. You will be required to use Google documents to present work and to adhere to agreed deadlines for completion and submission of assignments. You will present your work in a variety of formats: written, professional discussion, a short video blog and through the use of Google forms. A willingness to read and research will be required throughout the course. Documents for further reading will include policies, procedures and guidance from your school.

Support required from others

Schools are asked to consider the commitment taken by staff undertaking the course and to consider that they will need the support of a qualified and highly skilled LSA to support them through the process. Mentors could be students in school who have already completed the course.
