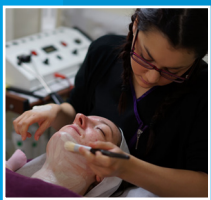

Work placements

High quality work experience is integral to the College's ethos. We would be grateful for a selection of work placements for students during the academic year (September to June). Perhaps you have an event or project that they could work on? Any activity or experience is worth considering as it is likely to be a developmental opportunity for students. Many employers have seen the benefit of having a young person around, with their fresh eyes and attitudes.

Estimated time commitment: Varied. Hosting young people to visit the workplace for a few hours, a half day, a whole day, a week or on a more regular basis.

Curriculum advice

We welcome advisors with a range of industry expertise to help inform the design, development and implementation of the curricula. This would include providing advice on what a specific industry requires of its employees as well as offering direction on technical/specialist training requirements.

Estimated time commitment: There is no specific time commitment. This would be dependent on the time you have available and the level of input you wish to offer. You may wish to attend focused workshops and respond to email/telephone requests, advising on the needs and expectations of the specific industry.

Industrial placements for staff

Estimated time commitment: two days during the May half term
