Engineering

Health & Social Care

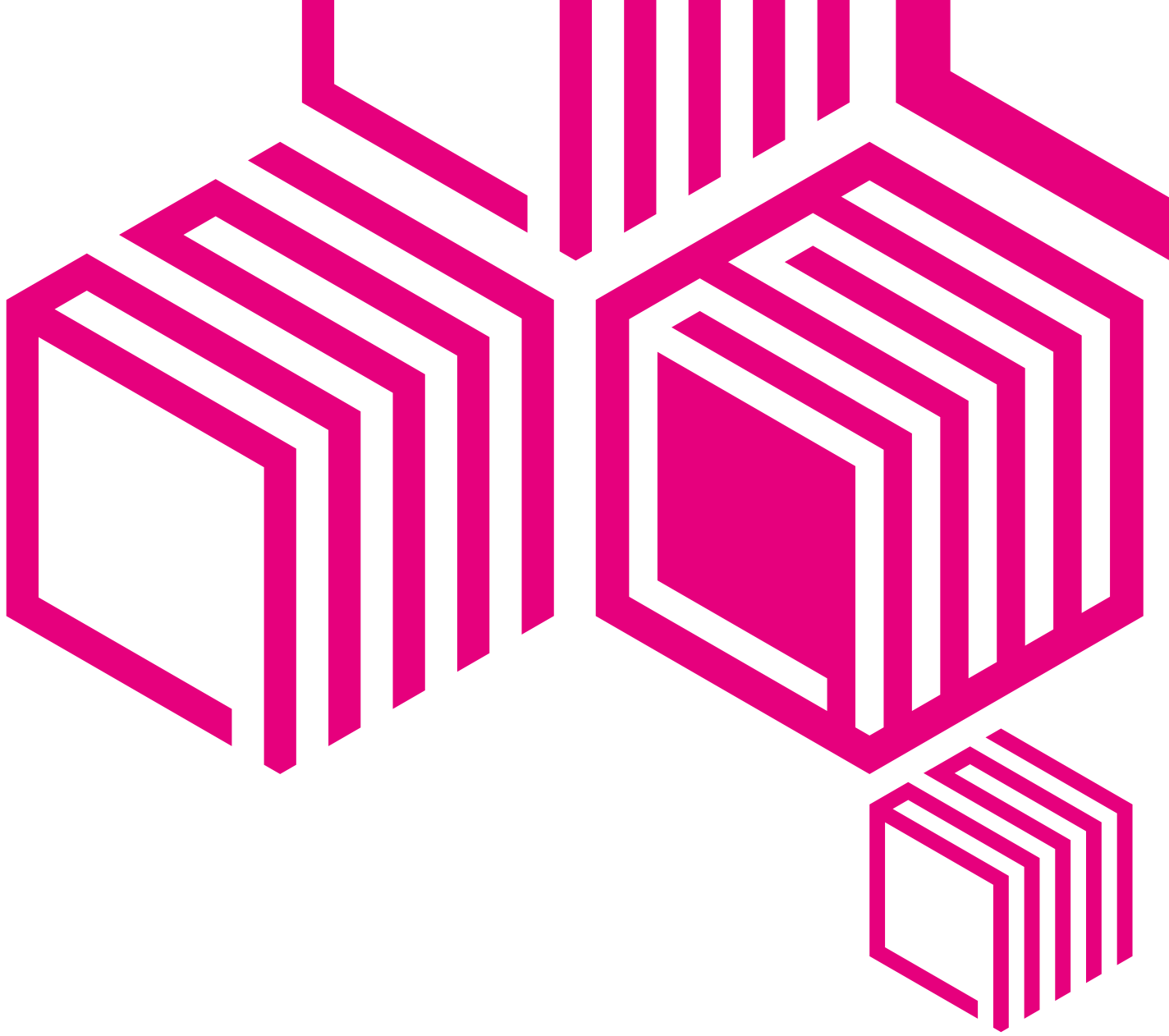
