Access

This course aims to develop students' self-esteem and confidence, improve their social, life and independent living skills and maximise their potential through an individual programme relevant to specific needs.

Business

This course is designed to provide students with an excellent range of employability skills to enable them to be work-ready either after college or university.

Childcare & Early Years

Ideal for those who would like to work in any area of health, social care or early years. Level 3 develops the knowledge/experience to work with children from birth to five years, with knowledge of five to seven years.

Creative & Digital Arts

These courses are designed to give students a wide and varied exposure to the many different types of creative media focusing on the essential skills required for all creative industries.

Engineering

These courses will develop students' practical skills and knowledge and are the ideal first step towards a successful and rewarding career in this exciting and varied sector.

Health & Social Care

Level 2 is ideal for those seeking to work in any area of health, social care or early years. Level 3 is a stepping stone to higher education at university/college or to taking up employment in the sector.

IT & Computing

These courses will provide students with up-to-date technical content and the necessary knowledge, understanding, skills and attributes required to be successful in this sector.

Performing Arts

Ideal for those with a burning ambition to be a performer/work within the performing arts sector. Most of our Level 3 students progress to UK universities, drama or dance schools.

This course is available to employees currently working in the electrical contracting or supply industry or those whose work involves electrical installation, maintenance, repair or modification of existing installations.

Engineering – Welding

These courses are available to employees currently working as engineer operatives, technicians, fabricators and welders within the engineering industry.

Hairdressing

This course is available to employees currently working in the hairdressing industry.

Horticulture

This course is available to employees currently working in horticulture, landscaping, production horticulture, sports turf or park and gardens.

Hospitality Leadership

This course is available to employees currently working in the hospitality and catering industry.

Motor Vehicle

This course is available to employees currently working as technicians in garages and dealerships within the motor industry.

Office Administration

This is a Nordic-style 'Career Launch' apprenticeship where students will attend college on a full-time basis from September to February. They will then take on employment and attend college on a day release basis for a further 10 months to complete the qualification.

Plumbing Studies

This course is available to employees currently working as plumbers in the construction industry and associated trades.

Retail Skills

This course is aimed at those wishing to pursue a career within the retail sector.

Retail – Trainee Management

This course is aimed at those wishing to pursue a career within retail manage

Site Carpentry & Bench Joinery


